On February 2nd, 2008 AD the Anglican Orthodox Church passed a great milestone in her history as a Traditional, Reformation Anglican Church. With the kind assistance of Presiding Bishop Charles Morley and Bishop Del Murray of the Traditional Protestant Episcopal Church as co-consecrators, we consecrated to the Episcopate the Rt. Rev. Dennis Campbell and the Rt. Rev Garth Neel. Bishop Campbell will serve as Bishop Coadjutor of the AOC, and Bishop Neel as Bishop of Latin American Missions.

Both of these men have proven through their life and witness to be worthy of this high Calling in Christ. Photos and details of this momentous event will be forwarded to you in separate mailings.

Bishop Campbell is rector of Holy Trinity AOC Church in Powhattan, Virginia, and Bishop Neel of Saskatchewan, Canada, is our missionary to Peru, Argentina, and Columbia. His role will include all Latin American ministries as they develop. Both men are graduates of respected seminaries and both have ministered for most of the adult years of their lives. We are humbled that the Lord has sent such men to work with us in reaching the world for Christ.

Our founding Bishop, the Most Rev. James Parker Dees, courageously struggled for three decades without the benefit of assistance in Episcopal Orders. The Lord has now provided these two men, and we can now feel confident that the AOC will continue far into the future as a Church whose foundations are anchored in Christ. Bishop Dees would have been greatly comforted to see this day and we celebrate in it.

Please pray for these two Bishops that the Lord will prosper, sustain, and guide them as they take on this role of greater responsibility and commitment entrusted to them in the Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ.
