The Rev. John Patterson Proclaiming God's Word in our Nation's Capitol

On January 22, 2010, The Rev. John Patterson was invited to participate in a Pro-life Christian service at our nation's Capitol by Rev. Rob Schenck of Faith and Action in Washington D.C. This was the anniversary of Roe vs. Wade decision of the United States Supreme Court. The event was held in the Congressional Auditorium underneath the Capitol. The work of the Faith and Action ministry is threefold. First, they promote the sanctity of human life in the womb. Second, they proclaim the necessity of the marriage covenant as valid only between a man and a woman. Lastly, they fight for the First Amendment rights of Christians to proclaim truth in the Public square. Faith and Action does this by trying to influence Congress and the Supreme Court. The Rev. John Patterson is asking that people pray that God would awaken many to the truth of the gospel and that our nation's leaders would reflect this. He states it is important that a Christian witness be maintained PUBLICLY and that governments at all levels respect this witness. This was his reason for going to Washington to publicly proclaim God's Word on the subject. The Rev. John Patterson says God's truth is not for church and family only. It is for society and those who govern as well.
